If elected, what would be your first priority as a School Board Member?

My first priority is to support the overall well-being of our students, teachers, and staff. This includes support for behavioral health, as well as ensuring families have access to services they need to survive and thrive. The specific strategy for this is expanding and supporting the Community Schools model, and promoting the 100% New Mexico initiative within Socorro County.

Parents working together with teachers, counselors, and administrators to identify and coordinate support for their children would help cultivate connection that would serve the entire community. This would be built on mutual respect with a shared goal of providing the best education and any other support that the student needs. What would you do to improve student academic outcomes?

Currently, our school district is participating in a 6-year School Improvement Project through the Cooperative Educational Services (CES) and funded by the NMPED.

CES will conduct an extensive assessment of all programs and practices in our district, and provide a customized strategic plan. This is an incredible opportunity to get unbiased and well-informed feedback and best practices that we can implement in our schools, and will provide a roadmap for improving student academic outcomes. Another important strategy is to cultivate a sense of self-worth and self-confidence in students.

As a returning school board member, I carefully reviewed the process our district used for selecting curriculum. It included consideration of different curriculum reviewed and rated by the NMPED, input from the teachers teaching the material, and parents. I can review best-practices in subject matter I am familar with (STEM fields), but prefer to rely on the expertise of the folks teaching the material to provide good input in the review process.

This aligns with the Community Schools model, and I strongly support students having access to these services (and more) while at school.

There are cases when teenagers are trying to be responsible but who do not feel safe confiding in parents with specific health concerns. I would support the privacy of the students and respect their efforts to take control of their health.

I am currently a full professor and the Chair of the Physics Department, and I am the Director of STEM Outreach at New Mexico Tech. I have also served on the Socorro Consolidated School Board since January 2020, and I have a leadership role in the 100% Socorro Initiative. I am dedicated to education and service.
