

## RE: Oppose HB 12 Extreme Risk Firearm Protection Order Changes

Mr./Madame Chair and Committee Members:

The New Mexico Business Coalition (NMBC) represents hundreds of businesses and thousands of New Mexicans. We focus on making New Mexico a better place to live and work, with abundant good-paying jobs to provide for our families.

NMBC respectfully opposes HB 12 Extreme Risk Firearm Protection Order Changes. This bill enables individuals to be deprived of their rights and personal property and to be subjected to invasive searches based solely on one party's assessment that they might commit a crime in the future. This is a deeply troubling concept, as we cannot justify imprisoning or punishing someone based on speculation about what they might do.

As outlined in this bill's search warrant provisions, a single round of ammunition could be concealed anywhere within a home. Allowing invasive search warrants based solely on the judgment of an uninvolved third party fundamentally undermines Fourth Amendment rights, which protect against unreasonable government searches and seizures. These provisions violate multiple constitutional protections and establish a dangerous and concerning precedent.

Additionally, New Mexico's "Extreme Risk Protection Order" has been a failed concept since its inception. It does not meaningfully help individuals in crisis who need support and resources. Instead, it escalates already volatile situations and strips individuals of their rights under both the Federal and State Constitutions.

For these reasons, we respectfully ask you to vote 'NO' on HB 12 Extreme Risk Firearm Protection Order Changes.
