

RE: Oppose SB 279 Gas-Operated SemiAuto Firearms Exclusion Act

Mr./Madame Chair and Committee Members:

The New Mexico Business Coalition (NMBC) represents hundreds of businesses and thousands of New Mexicans. We focus on making New Mexico a better place to live and work, with abundant good-paying jobs to provide for our families.

NMBC strongly opposes SB 279, the Gas-Operated Semiautomatic Firearms Exclusion Act. This bill seeks to ban the importation, sale, manufacture, transfer, receipt, or possession of gasoperated semiautomatic firearms in New Mexico. It also prohibits magazines with more than 10 rounds and any accessories that increase a firearm's rate of fire or mimic the function of a machine gun. While certain exemptions exist for law enforcement, military personnel, and licensed manufacturers, violations of the act would be classified as fourth-degree felonies.

SB 279 is a direct infringement on Second Amendment rights and a clear example of government overreach. It bans commonly owned firearms, restricts law-abiding citizens from possessing or transferring them, and imposes vague regulations that open the door to further restrictions. Its broad definitions and mandatory certification process could criminalize responsible gun owners while unfairly exempting law enforcement, creating an unequal application of the law. Furthermore, the bill may violate Supreme Court precedents that protect the right to own firearms commonly used for self-defense, making it susceptible to legal challenges.

For these reasons, we urge you to vote "NO" on SB 279 Gas-Operated SemiAuto Firearms Exclusion Act.
