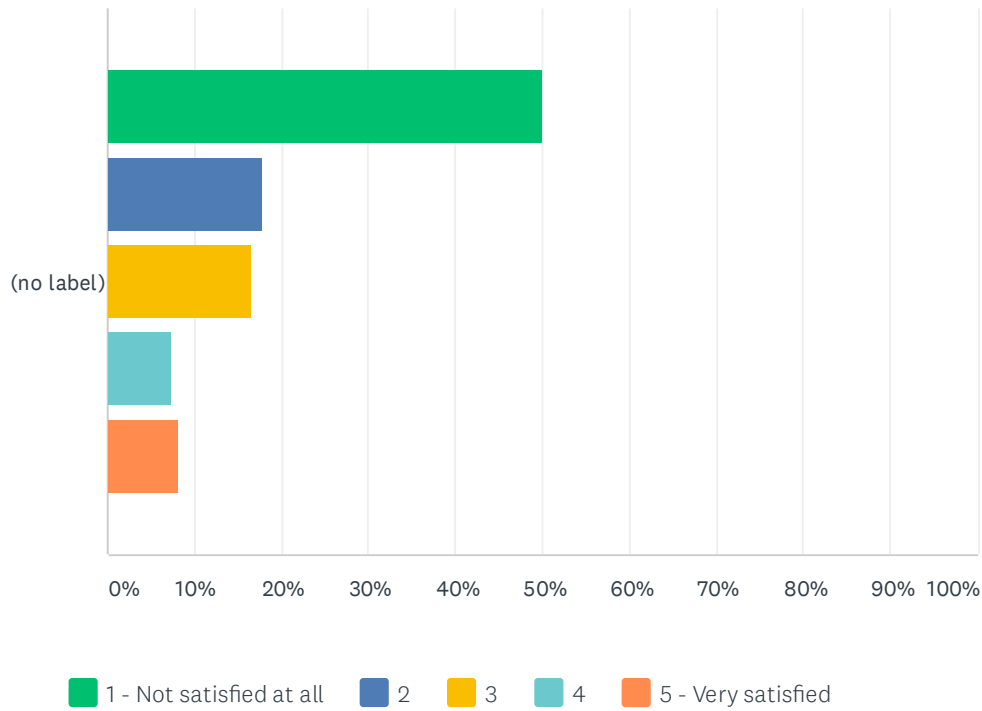

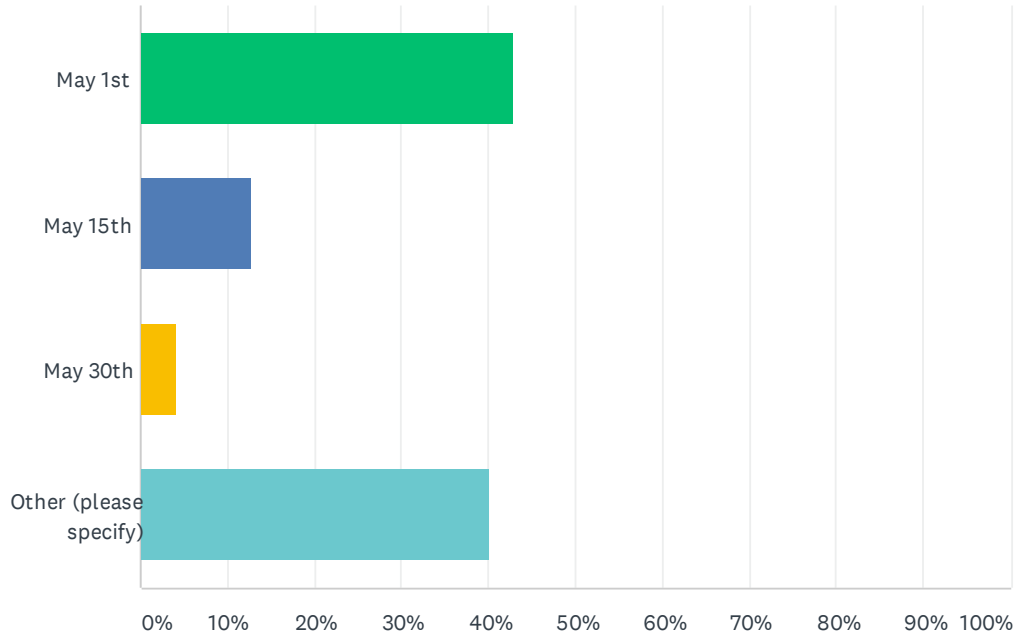

Q2 Currently the Governor's 'stay at home instruction' has been extended to May 15th. How long do you think 'stay at home instructions' should be in place?

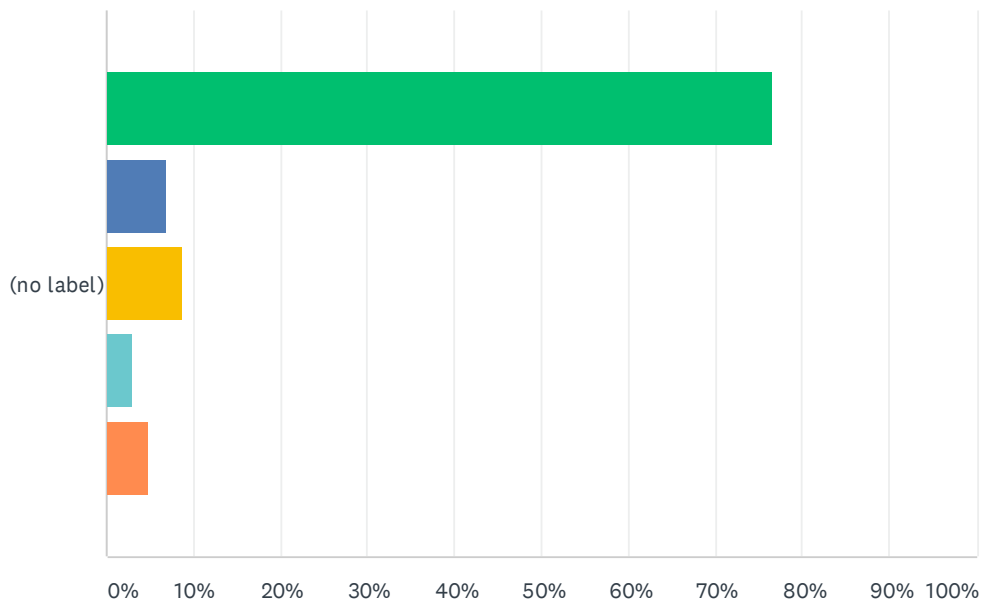

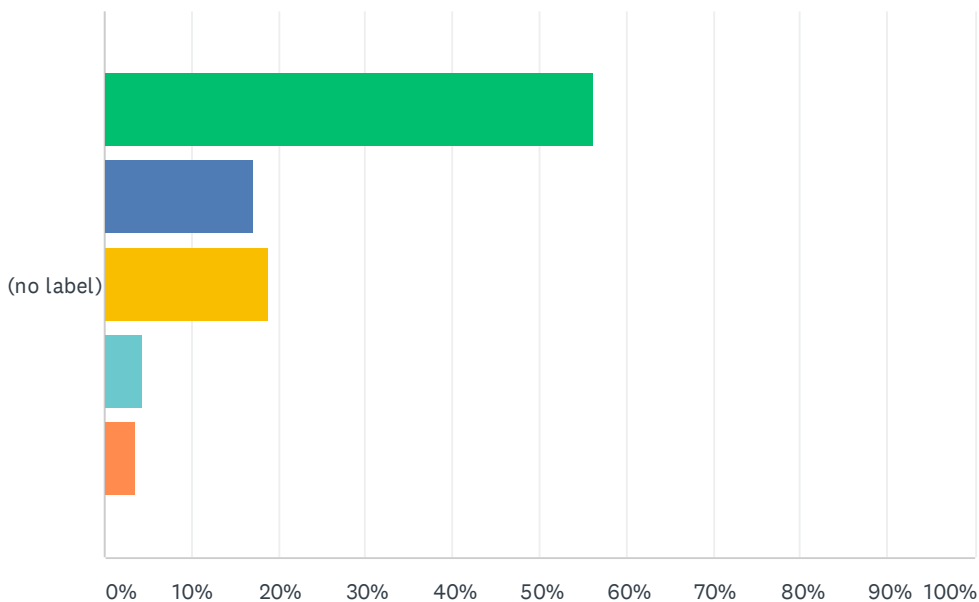

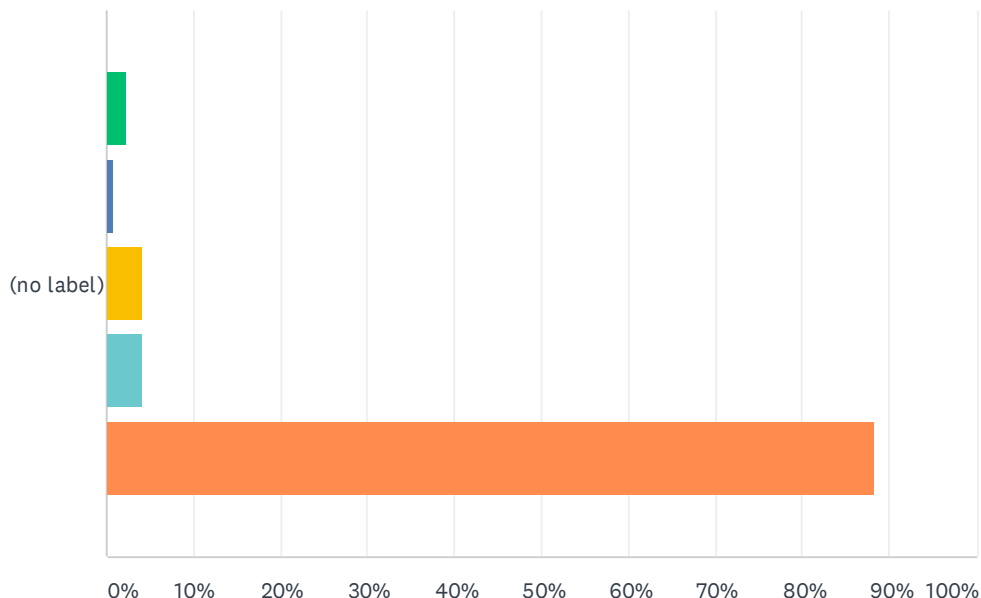

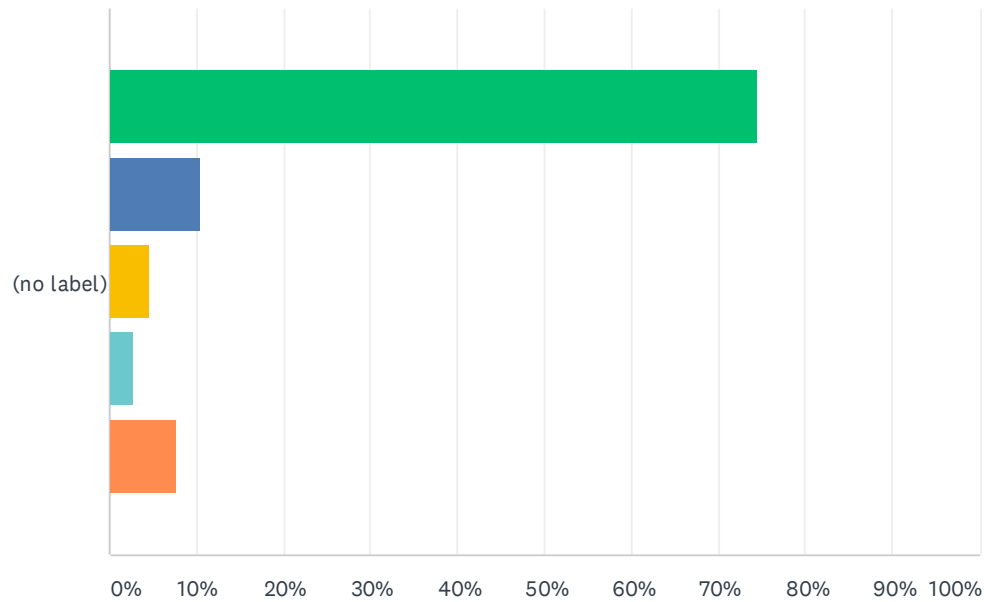
