5	operating within the City has been the subject of ongoing policy and			
6	legislative debate within the City since at least 2015 with the introduction of			
7	the "fair work week act" (O-15-57); and			
8	WHERE	AS, since 2015	the question of mand	latory minimum sick leave
9	within the City has been the subject of ballot initiatives, associated legal			
10	actions, and additional legislative proposals before the City Council; and			
11	WHEREAS, despite all of the continuous debate and expenditures of			
12	resources I	by both propor	ents and opponents of	of the various sick leave
13	proposals, workers in the City remain without minimum sick leave support,			
14	and employers remain subject to unpredictability as to their future potential			
15	sick leave obligations; and			
16	WHERE	AS, the question	on of minimum sick le	ave in the City impacts the
17	lives of wo	rkers, the liveli	hood and relative suc	cess of some businesses, and
18	the health,	safety, and we	Ifare of the City more	generally; and
19	WHERE	AS, given all o	f the various interests	and stakeholders and the
20	drawn out l	history of unsu	ccessful attempts at i	ninimum sick leave
21	requiremen	nts in the City,	a task force should be	formed from representatives
22	of employe	e advocates ar	nd associations, busin	less advocates and
23	associatior	ns, and others	who might offer exper	tise or insight; and
24	WHERE	AS, such a tas	k force will offer an op	oportunity for various interest
25	groups to i	dentify and dis	cuss specific issues,	options, concerns and possible
26	solutions o	or scenarios for	a base line sick leave	e requirement within the City

1 which may result in a better starting point for the City Council to craft a

2 workable sick leave ordinance.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF4 ALBUQUERQUE:

5 Section 1. A six (6) member Sick Leave Task Force (the "Task Force") is 6 established.

7 Section 2. The Task Force shall be made up of the following members:
8 A. Three representatives of employee advocates or employee

9 associations; and

10 B. Three representatives of business advocates, or business or trade11 associations; and

12 Section 3. This Task Force shall explore: a) options for minimum 13 mandatory sick leave requirements; b) options for exemptions of any 14 employers or employees as may be necessary or appropriate, and c) any other 15 relevant and helpful options relating to this issue. This Task Force shall 16 prepare a list of recommendations or considerations for potential legislation 17 that could help address issues related to the current lack of mandatory sick 18 leave and the present regulatory unpredictability for businesses related to 19 potential future sick leave obligations. 20 Section 4. This Task Force is a fact finding and recommending body and

not a final policy making body; accordingly, any meetings of this Task Force
are not subject to the New Mexico Open Meetings Act.

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
